- EVENTS:** Spring – World Class Division / Open Division

- MANDATORY EQUIPMENT:** All Sparring competitors must wear: white, red or blue headgear (red & blue headgear must be matched with chest protector color) and, red and blue reversible chest protector, forearm guard, shin and instep guard, groin cup (male only, worn inside) and mouthpiece. Each competitor must provide his or her own equipment. 12-14, 15-17 & 18-32 World Class Black Belt Divisions must provide their own Gen2 Daedo Socks. Gloves are mandatory for 15-32 World Class Black Belt competitors and optional for all others. Some equipments will be sold at the tournament site.
- OFFICIAL REFEREE:** WT International Referees and Certified USA Taekwondo National Referees will be officiating for high level transparency and fair play

COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

Sparing Competition Rules

All Matches will be single elimination and the most recent WT best of Three system will be used for all divisions. Black belt Cadets (12-14) and Juniors (15-17) will have one and a half (1.5) minute rounds and Senior Black belt competitors (18-32) will have two (2) minutes rounds. For (8-11) Black Belts competitors and Open division all Black belts and all Color belts will have one (1) minute rounds.

WEIGH -IN:

Weigh-In required only for competitors **Black Belts & Color Belts (12-14), (15-17) & (18-32)** World Class sparring division. Weigh in will take place at the tournament site on Saturday May 18, 2024 between **8:00 - 8:45AM**. Competitors will be allowed 2 opportunities to stand on the scale, during this time if unable to make weight on the 2nd try, competitors will be moved to the next division. We will have Daedo Sparring available for all Black Belt ages 12 -32 years world class divisions only. You must provide your own Gen 2 Daedo socks (electronic foot gear).

No Weigh -In for all Color Belts Division and Black Belts Open Sparring Division:

There will be no weigh in for all Open division. You must enter your correct weight during registration. If there seems to be a purposeful falsifying of weight information, you will risk disqualification. Competitors unable to meet the weight division listed during registration will not be allowed to compete and will be disqualified. (Competitors will not be moved up or down divisions due to falsification.)

***If there are less than 4 athletes in a weight division, the organizing committee may combine weight divisions.

***Athletes ages 15-17 (World Class Sparring Division Only) may compete in their own division or an older age division for their respective weight.

***Athletes 33 years and up (World Class Sparring Division Only) have the option to compete in their own division or the 18-32 years old division for their respective weight.
